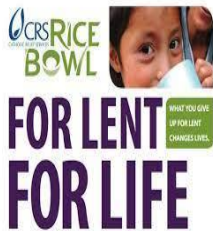

Special Diocesan Collection for Refugees in Poland this weekend: Over a million refugees, women, children and the elderly, have fled to Poland along its border. This surge of refugees has created a crisis of epic proportions. The rector of the St. John Paul

II Shrine in Kraków, Poland, is helping these refugees. The Shrine is a popular place of pilgrimage and has the ability to shelter many refugees, assist with meals, clothing, and basic needs. Any assistance diocesan parishes can provide to the Saint John Paul II Shrine in Krakow will aid countless Ukrainian refugees.
