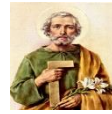

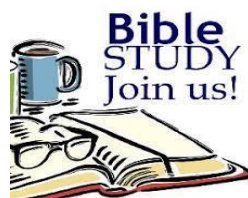
Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament:
